


### SACRAMENTS

### Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms at St. John's are celebrated one Sunday a month at Noon. Baptisms at St. Vincent's are celebrated each Saturday at Noon. Baptism Preparation Program is required for new parents. Please contact the Parish Office to register for Baptisms and Prep Class.

### Sacraments of First Eucharist & Confirmation

Two year preparation required. Please contact the Religious Education Office to register.

### Sacrament of Marriage

Preparation course required. Please contact the Parish Office at least eight months in advance.

### Ministry to the Sick

Contact the Parish Office if someone is unable to attend Mass and wish to receive the Sacrament of the Sick and/or Communion.

### RCIA

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process whereby adults become members of the Catholic Church. For information, contact the Parish Office.

### **OPPORTUNITIES FOR PRAYER**

Adoration Chapel at St. Vincent de Paul Church is accessible 24/7. The front door of the church is always open and the door to the chapel has a padlock. If you want to stop by the chapel to pray, please contact one of the people who will provide you with the access code. We do not yet have enough people to assure that there is always someone in adoration. When nobody is in the chapel, we close the doors of the tabernacle. **First Friday Adoration.** Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Benediction will be held on alternating months between the two churches; St. John's – ODD MONTHS; St. Vincent's – EVEN MONTHS.

**First Saturday.** The opportunity to fulfill the requirements for first Saturday devotion are provided. Every Saturday there are two Masses offered and every Saturday and Sunday confessions are offered.




