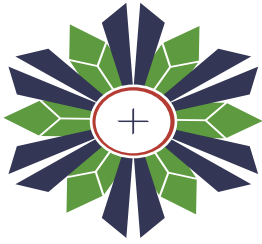
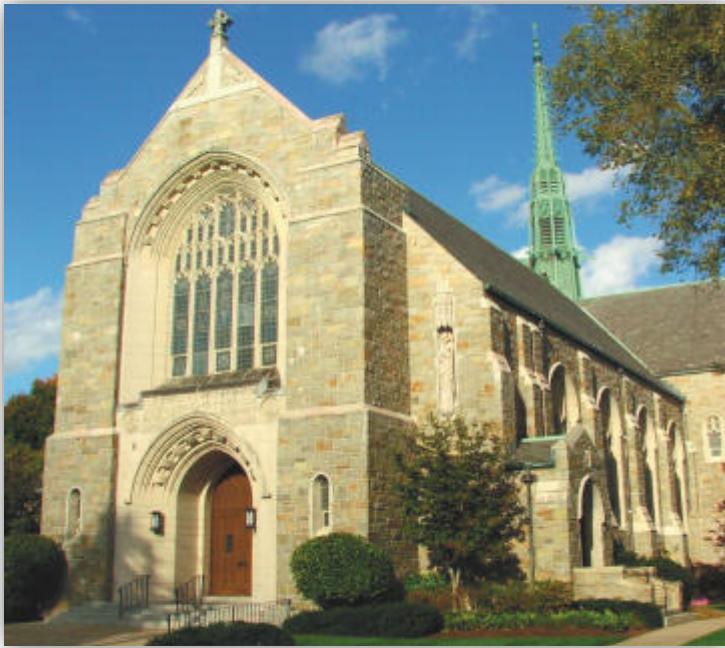

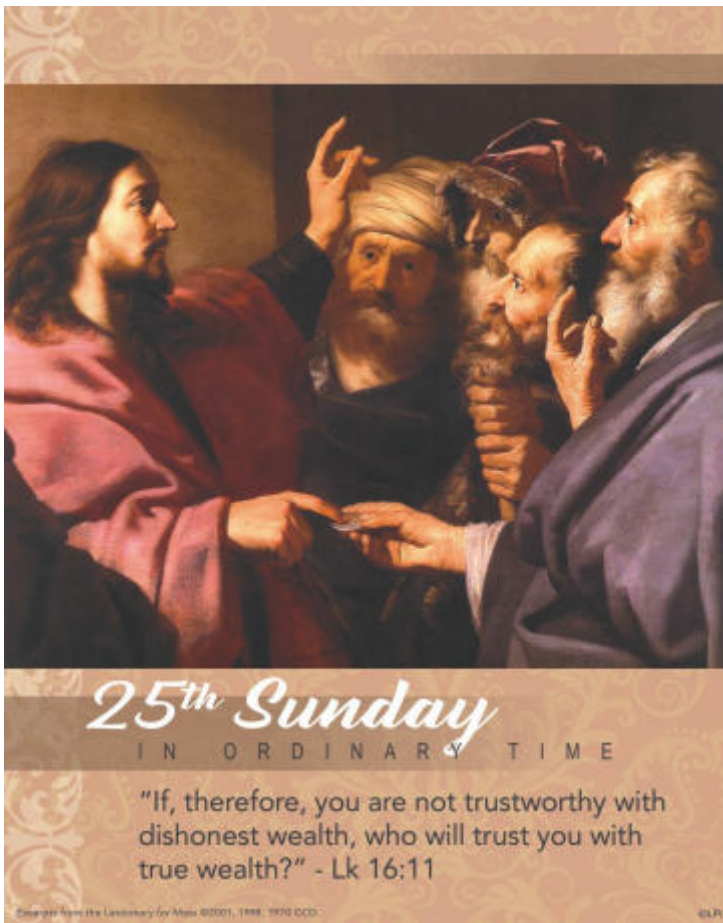

Students in Grades PK - 8 must be registered each year. New students are asked to provide a copy of their Baptismal certificate and sacramental information.

Family Mass: Our monthly Family Mass, held on the first Sunday of each month, will resume with the 10AM Mass on Sunday, **October 6, 2019**. All children are invited to sit up on the rug in the Sanctuary during the homily. We will be led in song by the St. John's Youth Choir under the direction of Mrs. Maureen Meriam. Youth lectors will proclaim the Word during this Mass. Any child who is in the fifth grade or above who is interested in lecturing during the Family Mass should contact the Religious Education Office. A parish nurse will be available for blood pressure checks and questions. Our next monthly Family Mass, will be on **Sunday, November 3, 2019** at the **10AM** Mass.

Office of Safe Environment/CORI: The Diocese of Fall River has established the Office of Safe Environment which is located at the Chancery. All CORI background checks are processed through this office. All new employees and volunteers who work with or have access to children in any capacity are **required** to have a CORI background check, and **complete a Safe Environment Training online through CMG Connect**. Upon completion of the training, a certificate is issued and attached to the paperwork. The Safe Environment Training is completed every six years. Returning volunteers who have already completed the Safe Environment Training must complete a CORI background and sign the Code of Conduct each year.
