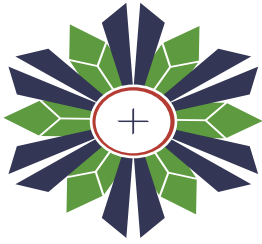
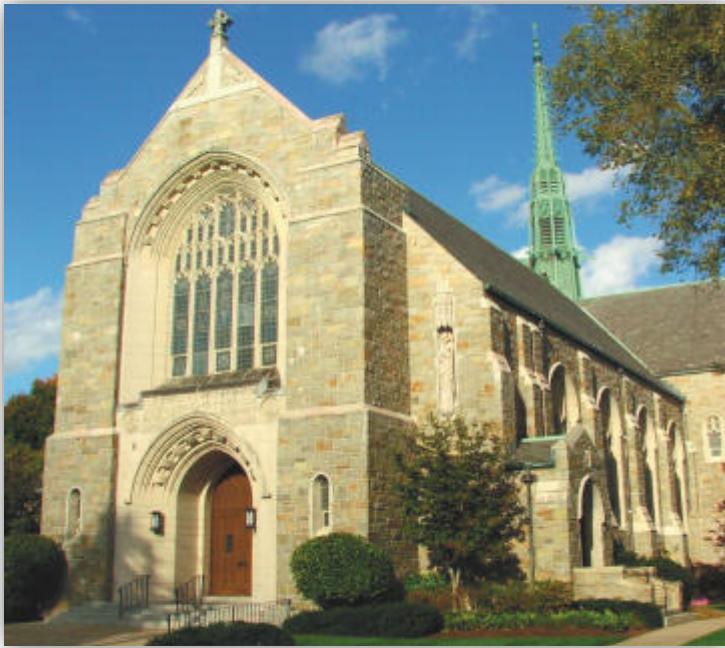

STRATEGIC PLANNING

Faced with challenges and changes, we plan for the future of our community of faith. The direct challenge in our parishes today is the decreasing number of people who go to church and the dwindling number of priests. In response to this, our Diocese and many others, implore the Strategic Planning process which invites two or more parishes/institutions to come work together as one faith community. **The goal of the Strategic Planning IS NOT to close or merge parishes!** However, this might be an outcome of the process in some cases. Change always requires sacrifice, letting go of what was done in the past, of what we got used to.

In our case we have three entities which are challenged to work together for the good of this community of faith, Saint John the Evangelist Parish, Saint Vincent de Paul Parish and Saint John the Evangelist School. Certainly, the first visible impact of this collaboration will be lower financial expenses as the three institutions share all possible offices and programs. The two parishes, for a while now, have been working under one central office; we just merged the religious education program; we have one bulletin and one website. And this is just a beginning as the Strategic Planning process is a long one, extending over many years.

As I began meeting with our Strategic Planning Committee, I noticed that some important guidelines were not followed in forming this group. Through the Bishop's office I was advised to dismiss this group and focus first on forming a Pastoral Council and then use this council to form a strategic planning group. To all those who were on our Strategic Planning Committee, I am grateful for your wonderful efforts. What are the guidelines that direct putting together any parish group of planning/advisory character? All members of such a group must be parishioners, registered and practicing. Couples, husband & wife, should not be in the same group. Every group must have a clear understanding what is the task of the group. Communication from such groups to the community must be done on official level; individual interpretations create misunderstanding.

What is the task of the Strategic Planning Committee? All parish groups, Finance Council, Pastoral Council, Strategic Planning Committee, have planning/advisory nature; they advise the pastor on making decisions. The Strategic Planning Committee's task is exactly what the name says, to plan and to prepare a guideline that will help the entities work together to have a clear vision on how to become one community of faith in all possible areas of parish life. The direct goal of this group is not to change or even improve things; if needed this should be a secondary outcome of the process. The main focus of the group, however, is to assist the three institutions, in our case, to work together for the good of the entire community. Once the planning is done, the committee will make their recommendation if we should remain a community with two worship sites or not. Then the group is dismissed and the Pastoral Council will begin implementing the recommendations. If needed, an Implementation Team could be formed to assist the Pastoral Council in this task.

Sacrament of Baptism

Parents requesting the baptism of their child should be registered members of St. John's or St. Vincent's and attend weekend Mass on a regular basis. Please contact the Parish office for a census form if you have not already registered at either Parish. If this is your first Baptism, parents are asked to attend a baptism preparation class. Classes are held one Sunday a month at Noon (no classes August or December) in the St. John's Hospitality Center. Advance registration is required. Baptisms are celebrated one Sunday a month at Noon at St. John's; and the second Saturday of the month at Noon at St. Vincent's. Families registered at St. John's or St. Vincent's are welcome to request any of the available baptism dates. Scheduling of the sacrament is dependent upon completion of baptismal paperwork (including Godparent sponsor certificates), preparation class attendance (if needed), and available space.

Godparents

Those to be Godparents (sponsors) must: be registered members of a Catholic parish; be practicing Catholics which, above all means going to Mass every Sunday; be at least 16 years old; be Confirmed; and if married, married in the Catholic Church. Persons who do not fulfill one of the above, cannot be Godparents. Once all requirements are fulfilled, they must obtain a sponsor's certificate from their own Parish. The sponsor's certificate cannot be substituted with any sacramental records like Baptism or Confirmation certificates. It should clearly state Sponsor's Certificate. Only one Godparent is required. If two are chosen, they must be one man and one woman. In addition to the one Godparent who fulfills all requirements, the second person may be of other Christian denomination, such person will be a Christian Witness. Catholics may not be Christian Witnesses. If the second person is Catholic, but does not meet the requirements, they may stand on the altar during the baptism, however, only Godparents and Christian Witnesses are listed in the Church sacramental registry.
