


#### **SACRAMENTS**

#### Sacrament of Baptism

Parents requesting the baptism of their child should be reaistered members of St. John's or St. Vincent's and attend weekend Mass on a regular basis. Please contact the Parish office for a census form if you have not already registered at either Parish. If this is your first Baptism, parents are asked to attend a baptism preparation class. Classes are held one Sunday a month at Noon in the St. John's Hospitality Center. Advance registration is required. Baptisms are celebrated one Sunday a month at Noon at St. John's; and the second Saturday of the month at Noon at St. Vincent's. Families registered at St. John's or St. Vincent's are welcome to request any of the available baptism dates. Scheduling of the sacrament is dependent upon completion of baptismal paperwork (including Godparent sponsor certificates), preparation class attendance (if needed), and available space.

#### Sacraments of First Eucharist & Confirmation

Two year preparation required. Please contact the Religious Education Office to register.

#### Sacrament of Marriage

Preparation course required. Please contact the Parish Office at least eight months in advance.

#### **RCIA**

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process whereby adults become members of the Catholic Church. For information, contact the Parish Office.




