


FROM THE PASTOR

WORK BEHIND THE SCENES: We are in the process of putting together a Pastoral Council, consisting of people from both parishes (therefore called pastoral instead of parish). The task of this council is to advise and support the pastor on all issues concerning the parish life. As such, the council has advisory character, but the final decision in all matters belongs to the pastor. The ex-officio and the appointed members will gather soon and then we will ask both parishes to choose elected members of the council. One of the first tasks of the council will be to put together a Strategic Planning Committee so the work of planning for the future of our faith community may continue.

Since last July we have been working hard on reconstructing and reducing our offices and ministries so that we will have sustainable finances. We have been reorganizing our parish offices, Religious Education Program, and music ministries. I am grateful to everyone for understanding the necessity of all changes, and above all, to those who decided to share their skills with us now as volunteers. By this time next year, our annual expenses should be reduced substantially. This should stop our financial downfall and no longer should we be in the red as we were for the last few years. Over the next few years we will still do some reductions so we will only pay for what is completely necessary. Our next step in this area will be to encourage parishioners to raise their weekly offering so we may not only survive but prosper financially. In the light of the homily I delivered recently, please consider your weekly offering for our parish to be a true sacrifice, and never a payment that comes with a demand. Along with your prayers, we will be a united and strong community of faith.





SACRAMENTAL MINISTRIES

Baptism: Parents requesting the baptism of their child should be registered members of St. John's or St. Vincent's and attend weekend Mass on a regular basis. Please contact the Parish Offices for a census form if you are not yet registered. Parents are asked to attend a Baptismal Registration Class. Classes are held one Sunday a month at 1PM in the St. John's Hospitality Center. Contact the Parish Offices to register. Baptisms are held one Sunday a month at 12PM at St. John's, and the second Saturday of the month at 12PM at St. Vincent's.

First Eucharist & Confirmation: Please contact the Religious Education Office to register. Two year preparation required.

Marriage: Please contact the Parish Offices at least eight months in advance. Preparation course required.

Ministry to the Sick: Please contact the Parish Offices if someone is unable to attend Mass and wishes to receive the Sacrament of the Sick and/or Communion. If you or a member of your family is hospitalized and would appreciate receiving pastoral visits, please be sure to state your religious preference and place of worship upon admission, and to indicate your desire to be visited by your clergy.

RCIA: The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process whereby adults become members of the Catholic Church. For more information, please contact the Parish Offices or email rcia@attleborocatholics.ora.


